



# Permanent Repairs to U.S. 74A – Chimney Rock (Project 18313.1081015)

### in Rutherford and Henderson Counties

From the U.S. 64 bridge and U.S. 64 / U.S. 74A / N.C. 9 intersection in Bat Cave to east of U.S. 74A / Terrace Drive intersection in Chimney Rock

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION


The U.S. 74A – Chimney Rock project will permanently repair damage caused by Hurricane Helene to U.S. 74A / N.C. 9 / U.S. 64, a two-lane undivided road, from its intersection with U.S. 64 in Bat Cave to east of the U.S. 74A and Terrace Drive intersection in Chimney Rock, approximately 2.6 miles. The project also includes the replacement of the U.S. 64 bridge in Bat Cave and Southside Drive and Chimney Rock Park Road bridges in Chimney Rock.

U.S. 74A will be reconstructed on much of its previous alignment. However, in some areas there will be shifts in alignment due to damage from Hurricane Helene and the shifting Broad River. The permanent alignment is still conceptual and technical investigations are underway to determine the most appropriate location.

Proposed concepts for the bridges are shown beginning on page 6. Two bridge concepts are proposed for the U.S. 64 bridge replacement in Bat Cave. Six bridge concepts are proposed for the replacement of the Southside Drive and Chimney Rock Park Road bridges.

Temporary access to Chimney Rock State Park (CRSP) will use Southside Drive, widening the current temporary bridge to two lanes until the permanent replacement bridge(s) can be constructed. Construction of the temporary access is scheduled to begin in April 2025.

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## PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of the U.S. 74A – Chimney Rock project is to restore and improve critical infrastructure damaged by Hurricane Helene along a 2.6-mile stretch of U.S. 74A / N.C. 9 / U.S. 64 from its intersection with U.S. 64 in Bat Cave to east of the U.S. 74A and Terrace Drive intersection in Chimney Rock, including the replacement of the U.S. 64, Southside Drive and Chimney Rock Park Road bridges.




# **Proposed Typical Sections**





### Chimney Rock Park Road and Southside Drive Combined Bridge





Option 2: Replace U.S. 64 Bridge on new location to the east



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
#### **RIGHT-OF-WAY PROCESS**

Once decisions are made regarding the final design of the project, the limits of the project will be staked on the ground. If you are an affected property owner, a right-of-way agent will arrange a meeting with you to explain the plans, how it affects you and your rights as a property owner.

If permanent right-of-way is required, then an appraisal will be completed, and an offer will be made to you based on that appraisal. The appraisal will be a fair market appraisal at the highest and best use of that property at that time.

#### NCDOT's policy is to:

- Contact affected property owners and conduct property appraisal
- Treat all owners and tenants equally
- Fully explain the owners' rights
- Provide current fair market value for property
- Provide relocation advisory assistance



#### **Relocation Assistance**

If your business or residence is to be acquired as part of the project, additional assistance in the form of advice and compensation is available.
