Eligibility

- Open to businesses and commercial property owners in the central business district of Lake Lure
- Have physical and financial losses due to Hurricane Helene that are not fully covered by insurance or other sources of relief funding (federal aid, grants)
- Have been in operation prior to the storm
- Plan to reopen and stay open for at least six months
- Provide a description of the business plans for reopening and operating
- Submit a full and complete application
